- 35 copies of the State's Application for Development Approval (includes Master, increment, and substantial deviation) or the Southwest Florida Regional Planning Council's (SWFRPC) Notice of Proposed Change.
- A draft-copy of the proposed development order or proposed amendment resolution on computer disk and submitted as 8 ½ x 11 size printed copy.
- 35 copies of the Conceptual Development Plan Map H (or two copies at a reproducible size, if legible at 11 x 17 or smaller).
- Appropriate filing fee with check made payable to the Charlotte County Board of County Commissioners or CCBCC.

General Information

The DRI application you submit to the Growth Management Department will be reviewed for completeness. If the application package is found to be incomplete, you will be notified within ten (10) working days from submittal of the application. An incomplete or deficient application package will not be scheduled for public hearing.

In addition to the completeness review, the County will participate in the SWFRPC sufficiency review of the project. We will not schedule the application for public hearing until the SWFRPC has notified the County that the application has been found sufficient according to Florida Statutes (F.S.), Chapter 380.06 (11) governing the DRI process. Please note the County requires a minimum processing time of four (4) weeks between the SWFRPC public hearing and the Planning and Zoning Board (P&Z) meeting date. There is a \$220.00 continuance fee for all continuances.

Whenever possible, DRIs will be heard at the same time as an associated comprehensive plan amendment petition. Rezoning petitions associated with plan amendments that require the review of the Department of Community Affairs will not be accepted or processed until after the Department of Community Affairs has issued the Notice of Intent to find the plan amendment in compliance. These associated petitions require separate applications and separate filing fees.
