The meeting was called to order at 2:00 p.m.

Minutes: No minutes were submitted for approval.

Business:

- Iguana Update - Ms. Musselman noted that the USDA has removed 1850 iguanas since January. The majority are non-breeding sub-adults. The breeders are now few and far between. This is good news.
- Paving Letter Discussion – Ms. Musselman gave an update on the responses that were mailed to all owners. She has received 59 emails regarding the subject. 21 supported the project, 29 were against, and 9 were looking for more information. There were a variety of reasons for the different responses.
- FY10 Paving Program - Mr. Halfhill and Mr. Keyser discussed the proposed paving program and the benefits of moving forward with the program in FY10. Mr. Halfhill discussed the possible creation of a Countywide MSTU to fund infrastructure maintenance and paving.
- The FY10 budget and financial reports were reviewed.
