The following are the tentative millage rates for FY07/08:

Countywide total:	4.6426
Environmentally Sensitive Land Program:	0.2000
Greater Charlotte Street Lighting District:	0.1925
Charlotte Public Safety Unit:	1.4347
Pedro/Knight Island Street/Drainage Unit:	1.8012
Manasota Key Street & Drainage Unit:	0.7798
Stump Pass Beach Renourishment:	0.1978
Sandhill Municipal Service Taxing Unit:	0.7062

The rates will be included on the TRIM notices to be sent out no later than August 24, 2007. These rates can be lowered at the 2 public hearings in September, but the millage rate adopted at the final hearing cannot be higher than the proposed rate that is submitted on the DR-420.
