

Please be advised that the State has passed a new site selection process for Community Residential Homes. This statute affects the process and procedures for the following facilities or homes for six (6) or less residents:

- Group Homes/ Transitional Housing
- Assisted Living Facilities
- Adult Congregate Living Facility
- Adult Daycare Facilities (This does not include child daycare)

Section 3-9-36.1 currently regulates these types of facilities; however, this new statute now supersedes the County's regulation. This means that the above mentioned facilities that are licensed by the state may be permitted in an RSF and RMF district without county approval (Special Exception) for six (6) residents or less. The only thing the County must do is verify the proximity of the site.

Item # (8) within the RSF district regulation, under Special Exceptions, is no longer valid for Adult Daycare Facilities.
